

Book Ideas



Gone Camping: A Novel in Verse

- Themes: Novel-in-Verse | Realistic Fiction | Camping
- Introduce novels-in-verse by reading a few pages or using the <u>ebook preview</u> of *Gone Camping*.
- Choose a poem with multiple voices and select a cast to read it aloud or read it aloud yourself, narrating with multiple voices.
- Explore story elements like character and setting with this Story Map.
- Read the rest of the story and update your story map as you go.
