

Book Ideas




El Deafo

Themes: Graphic Novels | Disability | Biography

- Introduce the author with this Meet-the-Author Recording.
- Read a few pages from the book or use the <u>ebook preview</u> to begin a conversation about how images and text work together.
- Encourage students to pause and reflect on the cultural representation of characters, setting, and events with this <u>Cultural Representation Reflection</u>.
- Research meningitis, hearing aids, or other topics to connect to the author's experience.

Themes: Spare Prose | Animals | Friendship

- Use this book trailer and ask students to write 3 facts they saw.
- Compare the book trailer with this <u>Meet-the-Author Recording</u>. Ask readers what additional information they learned.
- Find extension activities that compliment reading the book aloud.
- Continue Ivan's journey by reading additional titles from the Ivan and Friends Series.

Author Study Ideas

- Listen to the author's <u>Audio Name Pronunciation</u> and have students share with a partner one thing they learned.
- Listen to this <u>Meet-the-Author Recording</u> for *New Kid* to discover how Craft's life experiences impacted the writing and illustrations in the book.
- Browse more titles by the author.
- Use the share tool to create a shelf card for the <u>author</u>, adding to book baskets, displays, or shelves.
