

Book Ideas




Thank You, Mr. Falker

Themes: Realistic Fiction | Disability | School

- Introduce readers to the author by listening to her Audio Name Pronunciation.
- View <u>Meet-the-Author Movie #1</u> to learn about Polacco's struggles at school and how that shaped her story.
- Encourage discussion throughout the story with this <u>educator's guide</u> while watching the <u>complete video reading</u>.
- Access lesson extension ideas like having students write "thank you" pages for a class book, from this lesson plan.

Themes: Biography | Latino (Latin America) | Holiday

- Discover several reasons why Duncan Tonatiuh wrote *Funny Bones* in his Meet-the-Author Recording.
- Read the book, listen to the <u>audiobook excerpt</u>, or view the <u>ebook preview</u> to learn more about the artist, Guadalupe Posada.
- Explore forms of printmaking and other lesson extension ideas in this guide.
- Encourage students to read other titles by <u>Duncan Tonatiuh</u>, compare the illustrations, and share their thoughts with a partner.

Author Study Ideas

- Introduce readers to the author by playing her Audio Name Pronunciation.
- Play the Meet-the-Author Recording of Talkin' About Bessie to start a conversation about role models. Ask readers to think about their role models.
- Learn about others who have contributed to society by exploring other titles by Nikki Grimes.
- Use the share tool to create a shelf card for the <u>author</u>, adding to book baskets, displays, or shelves.
